When will the work be done?

Demolition started on 6 July 2026 and is expected to last until mid-September 2026. After demolition, we will prepare the site for the next phase of the new building.

What do you notice about this?

During the work, you should take into account:

- * extra noise during school hours (especially after the construction holiday);
- * construction traffic in the vicinity of the school;
- * construction traffic that will drive in and out of the school grounds;
- * an enclosed construction site.

We do our best to keep the inconvenience as limited as possible.

Safety first

The safety of students, employees, local residents and road users is most important to us. Together with the contractor, we have made clear agreements about working safely.

The demolition is carried out by Gebr. Stokkermans from Goirle and will take place entirely in accordance with the applicable (circular) guidelines. Before the construction industry holiday, the building will be dotted and the asbestos removal will take place, after the construction industry holiday, the building will be visibly demolished.

The asbestos removal mainly concerns indoor work that you will notice little of in the area.
